also known as condescension



## The 24-Hour Theory

#### Can also be known as Young Earth Creationism


- The days of Genesis 1 are literal 24-hour days, and that the universe was created in six days.
- Regularly paired with the view that the earth is 6,000 years old.
- Exodus 20:4



## The Gap Theory

#### Also known as ruin-restoration creationism

- Sometime after Genesis 1:1, Satan rebelled and God pronounced a cataclysmic judgment upon the once perfect earth. This judgment brought about the conditions described in Genesis 1:2.
- This view allows for the earth to be ancient while still interpreting the six days of creation as literal 24-hour days.
- Increasingly popular near the end of the eighteenth century and first half of the nineteenth century.

## The Day-Age Theory

#### Can also be known as Old Earth Creationism

- Each day of creation in Genesis one is an era of time.
- This view understands the six days to extend over millions or billions of years.
- Psalm 90:4 and 2 Peter 3:8



## The Framework Theory

- Genesis 1–3 is a polemic against the polytheistic idolatry of the surrounding culture.
- The six days of creation are understood to be a literary structure rather than literal 24-hour days.
- The first three days describe the forming of creation, while the second three days describe the filling of creation.



## The Temple Inauguration Theory

- Genesis 1:1-2:3 portrays creation in terms that would be recognised to the people of the ancient world as a temple building account. It is a description of creation as a cosmic temple.
- Genesis 1:14, 2:15



## The Historical Creationism Theory

- The Hebrew expression for "In the beginning" denotes an unspecified length of time—perhaps billions of years.
- The six days of Genesis 1 speak of the preparation of the promised land and do not refer to the creation of the earth or universe.
- Genesis 1:1, 3
